The Myth of Motu Nui Sauvignon Blanc 2021 (Chile) £22.90

Bright, aromatic and crisply textural. The Myth is a (125ml / 175ml) £5.50 / 6.95

Drop Dead Chenin Blanc 2019 (South Africa) £21

Full, ripe apple fruit mingles with tropical flavours (125ml / 175ml) £4.95 / 5.60
leading to a clean, dry finish. As ideal with food as it is without. (250ml) £6.95

Alto Los Romeros Gewurztraminer, Reserva, 2017 (Chile) £26

Pleasing intensity of fruit aromas with floral notes such as jasmine and white roses. On the palate it is light, with vibrant acidity, and a perfect balance.

Ontanon, Vetiver Rioja Blanco 2018 (Spain) £27.5

Opulent aromas of pear and jasmine, with tropical notes and well-integrated oak. The palate is poised with pineapple, vanilla and crisp lemon acidity – and brioche notes on the finish.

Signos de Origen 'La Vanilla' Chardonnay Viognier Marsanne

Roussanne, Casablanca Valley, Organic (Chile) £28

A seriously good Rhone style blend. Fruity aromas of apricots and white fruits with a floral side and notes of toasted almonds and butter. Robust and creamy on the palate with good acidity.

Riff Pinot Grigio Northern Italian Alps 2018 (Italian) £29

Brilliant straw-yellow colour with a green tint. Fine, fruity (apples and peaches), forward varietal aromas fresh. Light-medium bodied with a fresh mouth-watering finish, dry and crisp.

Cristobel 1492 Chardonnay, Mendoza 2017 (Argentina) £29.50

An attractive nose of exotic fruits is followed on the palate by more peachy fruit. The palate is fresh and clean with generosity, the finish long and fine. Best served with Chicken and Fish.

Reds

Pacamaya, Merlot 2019 (Chile)

£19

A soft, easy going Merlot with black and red fruit character (125ml/ 175) £5.50 / 6.95
juicy and well balanced. Ripe and plummy, ideal for current drinking (250ml) £7.95

Las Pampas Shiraz/Malbec, Mendoza

£21

A full, meaty wine with lots of spicy plum fruit and soft tannins (125ml / 175ml) £4.95 / 5.60
providing the structure. Nice weight and good in length (250ml) £6.95
this is a perfect blend of Malbec and Shiraz.

Los Coches Pinot Noir, Valle Central 2019 (Chile)

£23.5

Packed full of fresh red fruit character, this is classic New World Pinot from Chile. Good weight, plenty of ripe fruit and length and not at all jammy.

Passitivo Organic Primitivo Puglia 2020 (Italy)

£32

Intense ruby-red colour, with a complex bouquet, reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. The oak aging adds a pleasant roasted and spicy aroma. On the palate it is full bodied, supple and well-balanced with a long finish. One of our best sellers here at Patagonia WR

Tabali, Pedrogoso Carmenere 2020 (Chile)

£26.75

Deep dark red in colour with elegant complex nose, plenty of spice, black fruit and violets. On the palate there is a perfect integration between oak and fruit, filled by a long and elegant finish.

Amatua, El Porvenir Tannat 2020 (Argentina)

£33.5

Intense ruby colour with red berry fruit on the nose, along with spicy notes and hints of figs, menthol and eucalyptus. These lifted flavours continue to the palate and are backed up by smooth integrated tannins and fresh acidity to create a long finish. Red meat is the order of the day, with barbecued lamb or chargrilled steak being a good match.

Humberto Canale, Estate Malbec, 2019 (Patagonia)

£31.5

A refined style, both in the nose and in the mouth. Its careful oak ageing gives the wine an incredible dimension that turns it into an irresistible wine. Full bodied, with complex structure and surprising notes of red berries, eucalyptus, spice and black pepper. After a year in the bottle, it becomes more unctuous in character, intense and concentrated. You will find it hard to beat this wine on flavour and price!
